Message from Peace Palette

We are very grateful to have supporters and friends like you from the Ocean Grove Uniting Church. Thank you once again for your generous support in 2015. Peace Palette has lots to celebrate despite political and economical struggles in South Sudan, and we are very pleased to give you updates on new enterprises and initiatives that you have helped to bring to fruition.

- Community vegetable garden— We have cleared land and planted seeds
 of tomato, okra, African lady finger leaf and eggplant. This is a milestone
 in South Sudan communities and we hope other South Sudanese
 communities will replicate this.
- 2. Grinding service—Your donations helped to buy this grinder which can grind ten kilos of sorghum in just 10 –15 minutes. The income from this is approximately \$55 a day which is very profitable in South Sudan.
- 3. Peace Palette kiosk (forthcoming). Buoyed by the success of the garden and grinding service, we are starting on our 3rd social enterprise selling basic food and supplies.

Thank you again for assisting Peace Palette and ultimately helping the children of the Nhomlau Children's centre, who we believe, are the leaders of today and tomorrow.

Over the last few months a committee comprising of people from Wesley, St. Mary's Christ Church and UnitingCare in grove dale have been working towards creating a "drop in centre" for homeless and isolated people at 202 Myer Street Geelong, which is the Governor's residence at the old Geelong Goal. It will be known as "The Lazarus Community drop in centre and we will be

operating from Monday February the 1st 2016.
