#### VOLUNTEERS WANTED.

Over the last few months a committee comprising of people from Wesley, St. Mary's Christ Church and UnitingCare in grove dale have been working towards creating a "drop in centre" for homeless and isolated people at 202 Myer Street Geelong, which is the Governor's residence at the old Geelong Goal. It will be known as "The Lazarus Community drop in centre and we will be operating from Monday February the 1st 2016.

We will have available for clients, showering and clothes washing facilities as well as a light lunch and other activities including gardening and playing pool. Initially it will operate on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm expanding to other days in accordance with need. We are requiring volunteers to help us run the centre and each shift will be for 4 hours.

A volunteer training day has been arranged for 9.30am Friday January the 22nd at Wesley Church 100 Yarra Street Geelong.
