The UCA is renewing its call for the immediate closure of the Nauru detention centre after another damning report into the centre's operations.

The centre belongs to us and we are responsible for all that happens there. The UCA is asking us to support this call to close Nauru detention centre and to transfer children and families back to Australia for care and processing and to sign the formal petition to be lodged with the House of representatives Standing Committee on Petitions.
