Word got around that a TV was needed. Phones rang, people conferred, offers were made, and within days a splendid, large and beautiful TV was loaded into my car and delivered to it's new home. Cables were plugged in, magical images appeared on the screen. Coffee was poured, biscuits were shared, and so I left Rocky and his friend from another place and culture...sitting and enjoying watching an early episode of "Doc Martin" together!
