# Follow up Ocean Grove Congregational Meeting and Election of Interim Church Council: Date to be confirmed

- This meeting will be held in the hall straight after morning worship; chaired by David Runia.
- We will be updating and seeking feedback regarding the necessary changes for the congregation in order to meet the requirements outlined in the letter (read out by David Runia during the Church service on February 20. 2022), particularly regarding the calling a minister and considering alternatives for the manse
  - Nominations will be received for the Interim Church Council whereby we are asking people to join for a period of six months.
    - Positions will be considered to be both Church Elders and Church Councillors.
- Diane Jones, Carol Naylor and Pat Reid will be responsible for giving out nomination forms as David Runia will be unavailable for a couple of weeks prior to the meeting.

Nominations must be received by Wednesday March 30.2022. We require two people seconding nominations and then an election will be held by consensus on April 3.
