Bring Them Home

A message from Combined Refugee Action Group.
Greens Senator Nick McKim has introduced the *Evacuation to Safety Bill*, that would offer immediate evacuation to refugees who still remain in Nauru and Papua New Guinea, a decade after the remote detention centres were opened.

The bill would allow roughly 150 people who are still in Nauru and PNG to temporarily live in the community in Australia until they are resettled to a third country, as long as there have been no adverse security assessments made against them. Those who are evacuated would also be provided with medical assessments and treatment as needed.

A Senate Inquiry Report on the bill was released and passed on Tuesday 8th March, and the Bill will be debated and voted on in the Senate next week.
