This statement was prepared with Annie and Kylie's input and has been forwarded by he Reverend Narelle Collas from the PPW and will give members of the Congregation some understanding of why Annie and Kylie are concluding their placement in Ocean Grove/Barwon Heads.

Annie and Kylie after several weeks of conversations with their professional supervisors and Ministry colleagues have discerned that they are not the right Ministers for this Community at this time.

They feel that the placement needs a more experienced Minister with a background in conflict resolution or an IIM with the authority to equip members in the governance roles and help church staff and volunteers comply with UCA regulations and the law.

Their principal concern is that the Placement Profile does not seem to match the reality of Ministry in this context. They feel that their vitality of call has been compromised by governance and conflict issues (details of which are not included for privacy reasons).

Following several attempts to help reconcile the parties involved, they have found that these conflicts were escalating. The disputes were having a significant impact on their core responsibilities as Ministers as well as their commitments to the wider church and studies at the University of Divinity.

PRC approved the early release for Kyle and Annie from this placement on April the 1st 2025 and the Presbytery Minister will continue to support both Congregations and Kyle and Annie through this difficult time.
